It is extremely important that the horse receives the minimum amount of hay listed in the table (or its equivalent in pasture) in order to maintain desired fiber levels in the total ration (i.e. gut function).
- (3) The oats may be increased or decreased depending on the body condition score of the horse, but the stated levels of GRO'N WIN® must be maintained.
